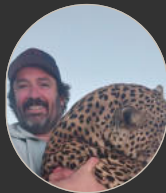

AUSTRIA

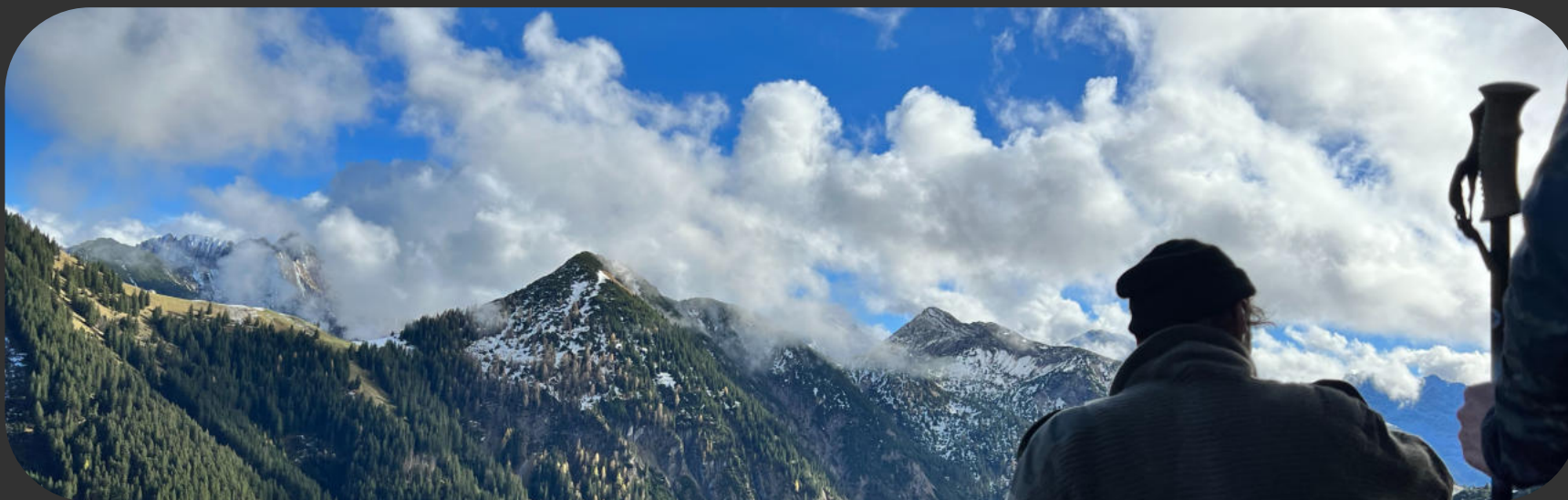

EASTERN EUROPE



Eastern Europe is one of the continent's most diverse hunting regions, bringing together rich wildlife populations, varied landscapes, and long-standing hunting traditions. Countries such as Bulgaria, Croatia, Hungary, and North Macedonia offer a wide range of habitats, from dense forests and open plains to rugged mountain terrain shaped by centuries of hunting culture.

Hunting in this region follows strong wildlife management and conservation practices. With a broad selection of game species—including Red Deer, Fallow Deer, Roe Deer, Wild Boar, Mouflon, and Chamois—Eastern Europe provides challenging and authentic hunting experiences across some of Europe's most varied natural environments.







BULGARIA

The Republic of Bulgaria is a country in Southeast Europe. It borders Romania to the north, Serbia and the Republic of North Macedonia to the west, Greece to the south, Turkey to the southeast and the Black Sea to the east. Its area is 111,000 km² and the population is about 6,600,000 people. Over 35% of the total area of the country is covered by forests.

Hunting programs

In Bulgaria, wild boar, mouflon and carnivores can be hunted all year round. From September 1 to January 31 for: deer, fallow deer, small game/ until December 30/ etc.

Wild goat - in October, December and April.





HUNGARY

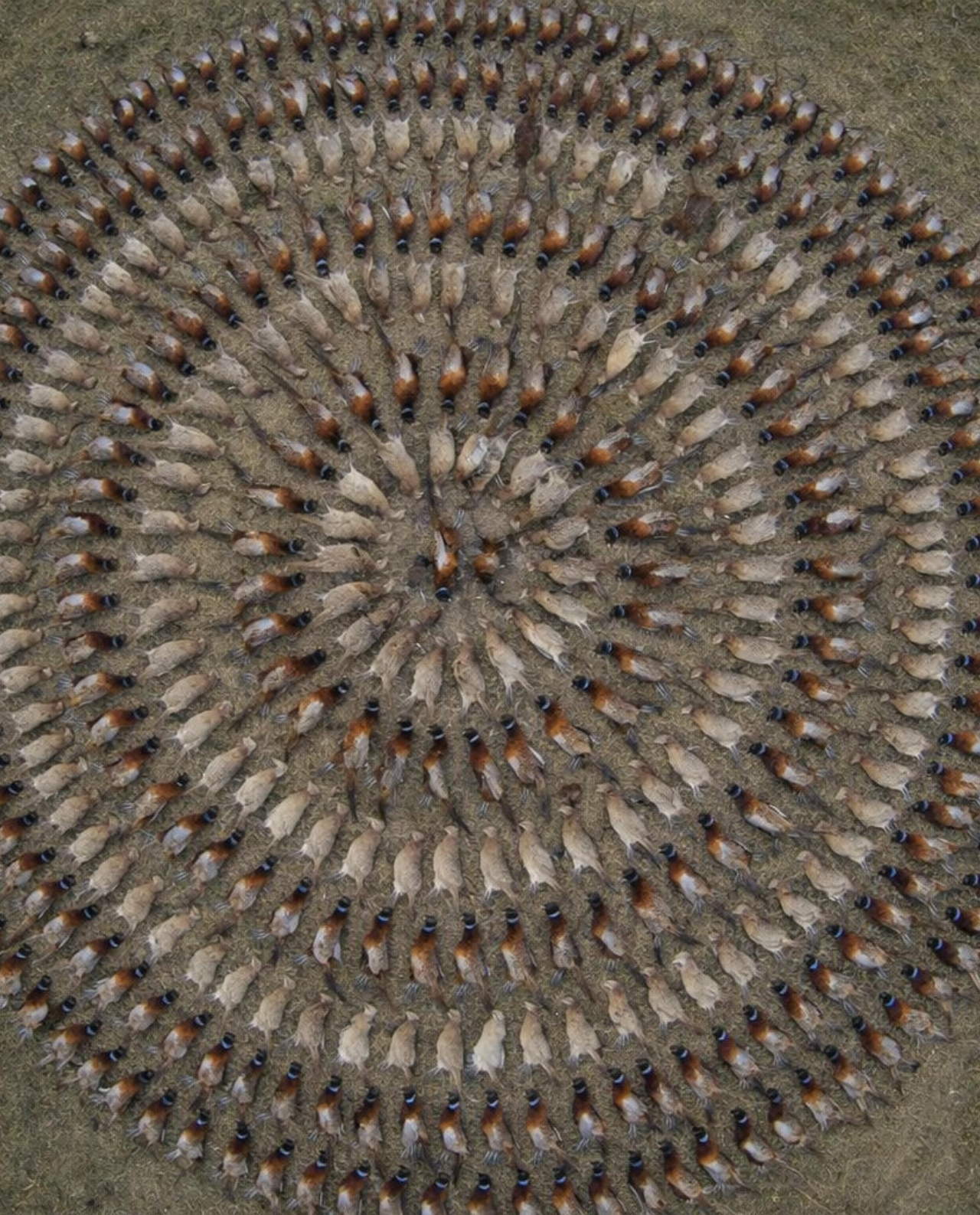
Hungary is a landlocked country located in Central Europe, covering approximately 93,030 square kilometres (35,920 square miles) within the Carpathian Basin. It shares borders with Slovakia to the north, Ukraine to the northeast, Romania to the east and southeast, Serbia to the south, Croatia and Slovenia to the southwest, and Austria to the west. Thanks to its central location, Hungary has historically been an important crossroads of cultures and trade routes in Europe.

The country is characterized by a mix of plains, forests, and river systems, including the Danube and Tisza rivers, which create suitable habitats for a variety of wildlife species. These natural conditions, combined with long-standing wildlife management traditions, have made Hungary a recognized destination for hunting in Europe.

Game types

Among the most common game species in Hungary are red deer, known for their impressive antlers and high trophy quality, roe deer, widely distributed across the country, wild boar, which inhabit many forested areas and agricultural landscapes, and pheasant, often hunted in traditional driven shoots.





CROATIA

Croatia is a country in Southeast Europe. It borders Slovenia and Hungary to the north, Serbia, Bosnia and Herzegovina and Montenegro to the east. In the southwest there is an outlet to the Adriatic Sea. Its area is 56,613 km², of which 56,500 km² is land and 113 km² is water. The population is about 4 million people.

Number of hunting grounds: over 15

Game types

Brown bear, wild boar, deer, fallow deer, mouflon, small game.

Hunting Programs

Croatia is the only European country where brown bear hunting is officially allowed. The season is from October 1 to December 1 and from March 1 to May 15. We also offer wild boar and small game hunting, in addition to other native animals.





MACEDONIA

The Republic of North Macedonia is a landlocked country and constitutes the northern part of the historical region of Macedonia, parts of which are located in Bulgaria and Greece. It borders Bulgaria to the east, Greece to the south, Serbia and Kosovo to the north, and Albania to the west. Its area is 25,713 km², the population is about 2 million people.

Hunting grounds: 4

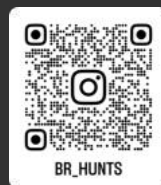

Hunting programs

In Macedonia, we have been organizing Balkan wild goat hunting for a long time. The season is from August 1 to December 30. Hunting of wild boar driven hunt and wolf: The season is from November 1 to January 30. Hunting of exotic introduced species: Himalayan tahr, kri kri ibex, Barbary sheep, Ratza rams, mouflon, sika deer, etc.

The program consists of 7 nights and 6 hunting days or 4 nights, 3 hunting days. There are daily flights to Skopje from Vienna, Frankfurt, etc. European capitals.
